### **SKOGLUND TROPHY (Men)**

Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish. Composite entries will be accepted.  
Games will be played on Tuesday afternoons with a start time no later than 1-15pm.  
Round one will be played prior to Christmas and will be a round robin competition.  
Round two will commence late January and will be played in three Divisions compiled from results from round one. Please ensure the club's convenor has a copy of the draw.

Please note all draws for Skoglund Triples & Elizabeth Walker will be sent to club secretaries.

#### **1. Playing Format**

2 teams, 3 bowl triples, 15 ends (no time limit).  
Dress is club uniform.

#### **2. Spotting/Re-spotting the Jack**

Jack delivery: If the jack goes out of bounds on the 1st throw it is to be placed by the opposing Skip and the opposing Lead may move the mat.  
Killed ends: Jack is replaced on the 2-metre mark

#### **3. Points**

2 for win  
1 for draw  
2 for total score aggregate over both games.  
In the event of games being uncompleted game points will be shared.

#### **4. Defaults**

Any defaults will result in the non-defaulting side receiving the game points plus the aggregate points. If only one team defaults, then the opponents receive that game's points plus aggregate points and the other team plays and that game's point's count. If an entire side defaults, the side will incur a penalty of (-6). Clubs should make all attempts to field teams and avoid defaulting.

#### **5. Cancellation**

It will be the responsibility of the host club to advise those clubs scheduled to play at that venue should conditions prevent play. Match points will be shared. A match will be deemed to be completed when all games have played 10 ends.

#### **6. Results**
