

Bowls Manawatu Champion of Champions Events

All General Conditions of Play (CoP) for Bowls Manawatu Events apply to all Bowls Manawatu Champion of Champions Events. The following CoP are specific to Champion of Champion events. Where applicable, these CoP supercede any General CoP.

Please note: A club member who has dual membership may only play in one club's championship discipline during a season, including but not limited to regular or substitute players. If a club member is found to have ignored this condition, then that player (and team) will be disqualified from the Bowls Manawatu Champion of Champions event as no substitute player will be permitted.

1. Eligibility

The team members of the team that wins a Club Championship are the players who shall be nominated by the club for entry to the Champion of Champions event. Any change in personnel shall be subject to the Substitution clause in the Bowls Manawatu General Conditions of Play. Where a club has only one entry, dispensation may be granted by Bowls Manawatu for that entrant to be eligible to enter the Champion of Champion event. Please contact Bowls Manawatu for approval.

2. Entries Close

Dates can be found in the Bowls Manawatu program Players and Teams competing are to be forwarded to the Centre Manager on completion of each Club's championship event.

3. Tournament and Playing Formats:

Singles	4 bowls	21 shots or time limit 2 hours	3 or 4 rounds/day
Pairs	3 bowls	18 ends or time limit 2 hours	3 or 4 rounds/day
Triples	2 bowls	18 ends or time limit 2 hours	3 rounds/day
Fours	2 bowls	18 ends or time limit 2 ¼ hours	3 rounds/day
Pairs 2x4x2	4 bowls	14 ends or time limit 2 ½ hours	3 or 4 rounds per day?

All games for Champion of Champions events are knockout games.

Play will commence at 8.30am for all Champion of Champion events except the 65 and Over events which will commence at 9.00am.
